

How to park at Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR)

Parking at Newark is free and easy, but not well known. Don't expect to find this information on maps of the airport or on the Port Authority's Website.

- ♦ Enter EWR by whichever route you'd normally take.
- ♦ Follow signs to Daily Parking – P4.
- ♦ As you approach P4, you will begin to see signs for Motorcycle Parking, adjacent to Valet Parking.
- ♦ Enter the garage; motorcycle parking is to your left, with overflow parking to your right. There are about twenty spots, all covered, well-lit, with frequent traffic from airport employees and garage customers.
- ♦ You do not need to enter the gate or pay.
- ♦ Exit the garage and cross the street to the (free) AirTrain, which connects to all terminals.
